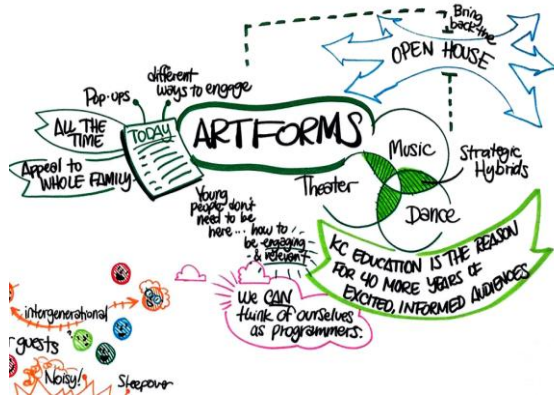


DRAFT Kennedy Center Education Division Plan

Mission: We set the national bar for arts learning, creativity, and accessibility by providing powerful, culturally relevant experiences for all.

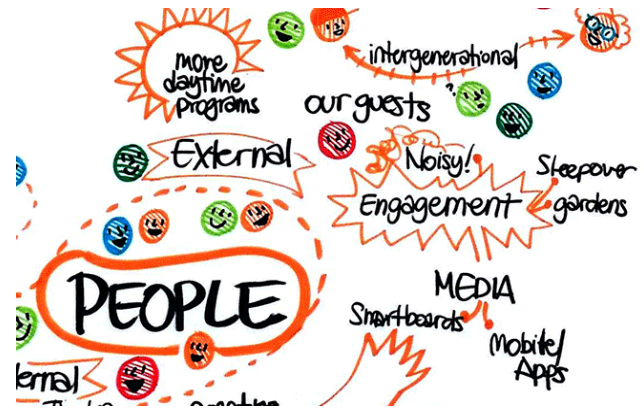
Vision: Eradicating barriers to arts learning. Building Capacity. Returning arts and creativity to the center of our lives. Activating Citizen Artists.
